



Enrollment Minimum

It's important to us that our students receive the full benefit of all our course materials, some of which includes small group interactive exercises. Academic researchers in the rhetoric and composition field have determined that well organized, small group interactive exercises facilitate student learning (as opposed to one-directional, non-interactive class lectures that do not encourage this kind of interactive learning).

Therefore, for optimal use of our course materials, Edge on English has instituted an enrollment minimum of 12 students for each class. Should we need to cancel a class in order to uphold this required enrollment minimum, we will provide a 3-business day, 72-hour cancellation notice to all registrants, along with the option of either forward enrollment or a full refund.

Refund Policy

All student refund requests must be made in writing—either via email, fax, or postal mail. Refunds will be made according to the refund eligibility chart shown below.

Refund Eligibility	
Full refund:	Requests made by or before the first class date
Prorated refund:	Requests made between the first and second class date
No refund:	Requests made after the second class date

Cancellation Policy

Should a weather emergency or natural disaster occur (such as fire, flooding, mud slides, or an earthquake), a cancellation notice will be issued to all registered students as quickly as possible, along with the option of either forward enrollment or a full refund.
